To suspend temporarily the duty on a certain chemical used in the textile industry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.61.06	Phosphonic acid,(1-hydroxyethylidene)bis-, tetrasodium salt (CAS No. 3794–83–0) (provided for in subheading 2931.00.9030)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2001	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section applies to articles entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
