## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on parts of certain  
magnetrons.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CER-**  
4       **TAIN MAGNETRONS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8       new heading:

“	9902.85.43	Certain magnetrons generating 10kw or more and pulsed (provided for in subheading 8540.71.40) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,  
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
