To temporarily suspend the duty on certain cathode-ray
tubes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.85.41	Cathode-ray data/graphic tubes, with a phosphor dot screen pitch smaller than 0.4 mm having a video display diagonal not exceeding 30 cm (provided for in subheading 8540.40.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,

- 1 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
