A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Commerce to acquire and equip fishery survey vessels.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Fisheries Survey Ves-

5 sel Authorization Act of 1999".

1 SEC. 2. ACQUISITION OF FISHERY SURVEY VESSELS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, subject to the
3 availability of appropriations, may in accordance with this
4 section acquire, by purchase, lease, lease-purchase, or
5 charter, and equip up to 6 fishery survey vessels in accord6 ance with this section.

7 (b) VESSEL REQUIREMENTS.—Any vessel acquired8 and equipped under this section must—

9 (1) be capable of—

10 (A) staying at sea continuously for at least11 30 days;

(B) conducting fishery population surveys
using hydroacoustic, longlining, deep water, and
pelagic trawls, and other necessary survey techniques; and

16 (C) conducting other work necessary to
17 provide fishery managers with the accurate and
18 timely data needed to prepare and implement
19 fishery management plans; and

20 (2) have a hull that meets the International
21 Council for Exploration of the Sea standard regard22 ing acoustic quietness.

(c) AUTHORIZATION.—To carry out this section there
are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary
\$60,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2000, 2001, 2002,
2003, 2004, and 2005.
