- 3 Section 441 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.
- 4 1441) is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 5 paragraph:
- 6 "(7) Any vessel required to anchor at the Belle
- 7 Isle Anchorage in the waters of the Detroit River in
- 8 the State of Michigan, for the purposes of awaiting
- 9 the availability of cargo or berthing space or for the
- purpose of taking on a pilot or awaiting pilot serv-
- ices, or at the direction of the Coast Guard, prior to
- proceeding to the Port of Toledo, Ohio, where the
- vessel makes entry under section 434 or obtains
- 14 clearance under section 4197 of the Revised Statutes
- of the United States.".

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
