## A BILL

To amend section 107 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to authorize the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to make grants from community development block grant amounts to the City of Youngstown, Ohio, for the construction of a community center and the renovation of a sports complex in such city.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Youngstown Commu-  
5       nity Center Development Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. CDBG SPECIAL PURPOSE GRANTS.**

2 Section 107(a)(1) of the Housing and Community  
3 Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5307(a)(1)) is  
4 amended—

5 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A)—

6 (A) by striking “\$60,000,000” and insert-  
7 ing “\$75,000,000”; and

8 (B) by striking “subsection (b)” and in-  
9 serting “this section”; and

10 (2) by striking subparagraph (G) and inserting  
11 the following new subparagraph:

12 “(G) in fiscal year 2000—

13 “(i) \$15,000,000 shall be available for  
14 a grant to the City of Youngstown, Ohio,  
15 for the construction of a community center  
16 in such city; and

17 “(ii) \$2,000,000 shall be available for  
18 a grant to the City of Youngstown, Ohio,  
19 for the renovation and refurbishing of the  
20 Sports Complex (formerly known as South  
21 Field House) in such city;”.
