Mr. TRAFICANT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To provide for the transfer of 10 percent of a State's apportionment of certain highway funds to the State's highway safety apportionment if the State does not suspend the driver's license of individuals under the age of 21 convicted of driving while under the influence of alcohol.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF APPORTIONMENT.**

4 On October 1, 2002, and each October 1 thereafter,
5 if a State has not enacted or is not enforcing a law that
6 requires in all circumstances the revocation or suspension
7 of the driver's license of any individual who is less than

1 21 years of age and who is convicted, after the date of
2 enactment of this Act, of driving while under the influence
3 of alcohol, the Secretary shall transfer an amount equal
4 to 10 percent of the amount apportioned to any State on
5 that date under each of paragraphs (1), (3), and (4) of
6 section 104(b) of title 23, United States Code, to the ap-
7 portionment of the State under section 402 of such title
8 to be used for alcohol-impaired driving countermeasures,
9 especially for individuals who are less than 21 years of
10 age. Such suspension or revocation shall be until the indi-
11 vidual's 21st birthday.

12 **SEC. 2. DRIVING TO AND FROM WORK.**

13 The apportionment of a State shall not be transferred
14 under section 1 if the State allows an individual convicted
15 while driving under the influence of alcohol to drive, dur-
16 ing the period of revocation or suspension of the individ-
17 ual's driver's license in accordance with section 1, only for
18 the purposes of going to and from such individual's place
19 of employment or to and from a college or other institution
20 of higher education or a trade school.
