## A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 10th Street and Constitution Avenue, NW, in Washington, DC, as the “Robert F. Kennedy Department of Justice Building”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4       The Federal building located at 10th Street and Con-  
5       stitution Avenue, NW, in Washington, DC, and known as  
6       the Department of Justice Building, shall be known and  
7       designated as the “Robert F. Kennedy Department of  
8       Justice Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal  
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be  
5 a reference to the “Robert F. Kennedy Department of  
6 Justice Building”.
