Mr. VISCLOSKY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To amend the Act entitled “An Act to provide for the establishment of the Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore, and for other purposes” to clarify the authority of the Secretary of the Interior to accept donations of lands that are contiguous to the Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Indiana Dunes Na-
5 tional Lakeshore Corrections Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF CONTIGUOUS LANDS.**

2 Section 19 of such Act (16 U.S.C. 460u–19) is
3 amended by designating the existing text of the section
4 as subsection (a), and by adding at the end the following:

5 “(b) For purposes of subsection (a), lands may be
6 considered contiguous to other lands if the lands touch
7 the other lands, or are separated from the other lands by
8 only a public or private right-of-way, such as a road, rail-
9 road, or utility corridor.”.

10 **SEC. 3. AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE LANDS BY PAYMENT OF**
11 **DELINQUENT TAXES.**

12 Section 2(a) of such Act (16 U.S.C. 460u–1(a)) is
13 amended in the first sentence by inserting before the pe-
14 riod the following: “, including acquisition from units of
15 State or local government by satisfaction of delinquent
16 State or local taxes”.
