4	Section 4(c) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973
5	is amended by adding at the end the following:
5	"(3) The Secretary shall request the National Acad-
7	emy of Sciences to review and recommend every five years
8	species included in each list under this subsection that
9	should be removed from that list.".
