## A BILL

For the relief of Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Robert L. Stockwell, United States Army.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT FOR SERVICE AND RELATED EX-4 PENSES.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Out of any money in the Treasury
6 not otherwise appropriated, the Secretary of the Treasury
7 shall pay to Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Robert L. Stock8 well, United States Army, of Overland Park, Kansas,
9 \$40,665 as payment for services (while in a retired status)
10 as Program Manager of the Private Office Independent

Outreach Program in Brussels, Belgium, during 1993 and
 1994. For purposes of section 911 of the Internal Revenue
 Code of 1986, such payment shall be treated as foreign
 earned income within the meaning of such section.

5 (b) PAYMENT FOR MOVING AND INTEREST EX6 PENSES.—In addition to the payment provided for in sub7 section (a), out of any money in the Treasury not other8 wise appropriated, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay
9 to Lieutenant Colonel Stockwell—

10 (1) \$21,838 for moving expenses incurred by
11 Lieutenant Colonel Stockwell in conjunction with
12 holding such position; and

(2) \$10,000 for interest expenses incurred by
Lieutenant Colonel Stockwell in conjunction with
holding such position.

## 16 SEC. 2. WAIVER OF PAYMENT FOR TUITION.

Any liability of Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Robert
L. Stockwell to the United States for tuition for his children to attend school while he was performing the service
described in section 1 is hereby extinguished.
