1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### **3 SECTION 1. POLICY.**

Federal assistance under the State and local clean air
grant program established by section 105 of the Clean Air
Act should be provided on the basis of environmental criteria. Arbitrary limits on the assistance that may be provided to States, particularly if such limits result in States

with significant air pollution receiving proportionately less
 than their respective populations and tax payments to the
 Federal Government, are an interference with the environ mental goals and policies of the Clean Air Act.

### 5 SEC. 2. GRANTS TO STATES.

6 Section 105(b)(2) of the Clean Air Act is amended7 by striking the first two sentences.
