1	SEC. 2. EXCEPTION FROM ENFORCEMENT OF CONSTRUC-
2	TION REQUIREMENT.
3	The requirement of section $804(f)(3)(C)$ of the Fair
4	Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 3604(f)(3)(C)) shall not apply
5	with respect to any building that—
6	(1) was designed for first occupancy during the
7	period beginning March 13, 1991 and ending on the
8	date of the enactment of this Act; and
9	(2) received a building permit or other similar
10	approval from the relevant State or local building
11	authorities as meeting the requirements of the appli-
12	cable building code.
