A BILL

For the relief of Phin Cohen, M.D.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
4 moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
5 Phin Cohen, M.D., of Brookline, Massachusetts, the sum
6 of \$927,966, in compensation for losses Dr. Cohen in-
7 curred as a result of providing information that enabled
8 the United States to recoup \$15 million of misallocated
9 Federal research grant funds.
