A BILL

For the relief of Phin Cohen, M.D.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
- 4 moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
- 5 Phin Cohen, M.D., of Brookline, Massachusetts, the sum
- 6 of \$927,966, in compensation for losses Dr. Cohen in-
- 7 curred as a result of providing information that enabled
- 8 the United States to recoup \$15 million of misallocated
- 9 Federal research grant funds.
