To declare as citizens of the United States certain women who lost citizenship solely by reason of marriage to an alien prior to September 22, 1922.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF CITIZENSHIP FOR CERTAIN

4 WOMEN WHO LOST CITIZENSHIP SOLELY BY
5 REASON OF MARRIAGE TO AN ALIEN PRIOR
6 TO SEPTEMBER 22, 1922.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any provision of
8 title III of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
9 1401 et seq.), any woman who was a citizen of the United

States, lost such citizenship solely because the woman
 married an alien prior to September 22, 1922, and died
 before December 24, 1952, is hereby declared to be a cit izen of the United States as of the date of the enactment
 of this Act.

6 (b) NO RETROACTIVE EFFECT.—This Act may not
7 be construed to affect—

8 (1) the citizenship of any person other than a9 woman described in subsection (a); or

10 (2) the citizenship before the date of the enact11 ment of this Act of a woman described in subsection
12 (a).
