3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "LAM Disease Research5 Act of 1999".

1 SEC. 2. PROGRAM OF RESEARCH ON LAM DISEASE.

2 Section 421 of the Public Health Service Act (42
3 U.S.C. 285b-3) is amended by adding at the end the fol4 lowing subsection:

(c)(1) The Program shall provide for the conduct 5 6 or support of research on the disease 7 lymphangioleiomyomatosis (referred to in this subsection 8 as 'LAM'). The Program may provide for the conduct or support of training, health information dissemination, and 9 10 other programs with respect to LAM. Activities under this paragraph may include the establishment and operation 11 of a registry with respect to the disease. 12

13 "(2) For the purpose of carrying out paragraph (1),
14 there is authorized to be appropriated \$5,000,000 for fis15 cal year 2000.".

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
