## A BILL

To amend the Colorado River Basin Salinity Control Act to authorize additional measures to carry out the control of salinity upstream of Imperial Dam in a cost-effective manner.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF THE COLORADO RIVER BASIN**  
4               **SALINITY CONTROL ACT.**

5       Section 208(c) of the Colorado River Basin Salinity  
6       Control Act (43 U.S.C. 1598(c)) is amended—

7               (1) in the first sentence—

1           (A) by striking “\$75,000,000 for sub-  
2           section 202(a)” and inserting “\$175,000,000  
3           for section 202(a)”; and

4           (B) by striking “paragraph 202(a)(6)” and  
5           inserting “paragraph (6) of section 202(a)”;  
6           and

7           (2) in the second sentence, by striking “para-  
8           graph 202(a)(6)” and inserting “section 202(a)(6)”.
