1 **SECTION 1. INCREASED FLEXIBILITY FOR TRANSFER OF**
2 **WITHIN STATE ALLOCATIONS BETWEEN**
3 **ADULT AND DISLOCATED WORKER EMPLOY-**
4 **MENT AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES UNDER THE**
5 **WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT OF 1998.**

6 Section 133(b)(4) of the Workforce Investment Act
7 of 1998 (29 U.S.C. 2863(b)(4)) is amended in the matter
8 preceding subparagraph (A) by inserting after “20 per-
9 cent” each place it appears the following: “(or 35 percent
10 with respect to a local board that represents a local area
11 in which the unemployment rate is at least 10 percent)”.
