A BILL

To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to require telephone carriers to completely and accurately itemize charges and taxes collected with telephone bills.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACCURATE TELEPHONE BILLING REQUIRED.**

4 Section 201 of the Communications Act of 1934 (47
5 U.S.C. 201) is amended by adding at the end the following
6 new subsection:

7 “(c) ACCURATE BILLING REQUIRED.—Notwith-
8 standing section 2(b), the Commission shall prescribe reg-
9 ulations to require common carriers to provide to its cus-

1 tomers a complete and accurate itemization of all charges,
2 fees, and taxes collected with any bill for telephone toll
3 service or telephone exchange service. Such itemization
4 shall include the amount collected for purposes of making
5 contributions for Federal and State support of universal
6 service. Such regulations shall require, at such interval as
7 the Commission may prescribe, a chart or other descrip-
8 tion of the amounts collected by the carrier and the pur-
9 poses for which such amounts are expended, and a state-
10 ment of the extent to which the amounts collected are re-
11 quired by other authorities or are determined by the car-
12 rier. The Commission may not forbear from applying the
13 requirements of this section or such regulations under sec-
14 tion 10 of this Act.”.
