- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Puerto Rico
- 5 Hospital Payment Parity Act of 1999".

SEC. 2. INCREASE IN BASE PAYMENT AMOUNTS TO PUERTO 2 RICO HOSPITALS. 3 Section 1886(d)(9) of the Social Security Act (42) 4 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)(9)) is amended— 5 (1) in subparagraph (A)(i), to read as follows: 6 "(i) for discharges beginning on or after Octo-7 ber 1, 2000, the Puerto Rico percentage (as defined 8 in subparagraph (E)) (and for discharges occurring 9 on or after October 1, 1997, and before October 1, 10 2000, 50 percent) of the Puerto Rico adjusted DRG 11 prospective payment rate (determined under sub-12 paragraph (B) or (C)) for such discharges, and"; 13 (2) in subparagraph (A)(ii) in the matter pre-14 ceding subclause (I) to read as follows: 15 "(ii) for discharges beginning in a fiscal year 16 beginning on or after October 1, 2000, the national 17 percentage (as defined in subparagraph (E)) (and 18 for discharges occurring on or after October 1, 19 1997, and before October 1, 2000, 50 percent) of 20 the discharge-weighted average of—"; and 21 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-22 paragraph: 23 "(E) For purposes of this subparagraph (A), for discharges beginning—

"(i) on or after October 1, 2000, and before Oc-1 2 tober 1, 2001, the 'Puerto Rico percentage' is 30 3 percent and the 'national percentage' is 70 percent; "(ii) on or after October 1, 2001, and before 4 October 1, 2002, the 'Puerto Rico percentage' is 15 5 6 percent and the 'national percentage' is 85 percent; 7 and "(iii) on or after October 1, 2002, the 'Puerto 8 9 Rico percentage' is 0 percent and the 'national percentage' is 100 percent.". 10
