A BILL

To provide for the appointment of additional Federal district judges in the Southern District of California.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Southern California
- 5 Federal Judgeship Act of 1999".

6 SEC. 2. DISTRICT JUDGES FOR THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT

- 7 **OF CALIFORNIA COURTS.**
- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint, by9 and with the advice and consent of the Senate, 3 addi-

tional district judges for the Southern District of Cali fornia;

3 (b) Temporary Judgeship.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint,
5 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,
6 1 additional district judge for the Southern District
7 of California.

8 (2) FIRST VACANCY NOT FILLED.—The first va-9 cancy in the office of district judge in the Southern 10 District of California, occurring 7 years or more 11 after the confirmation date of the judge named to 12 fill a temporary judgeship created by this subsection, 13 shall not be filled.

14 (c) TABLES.—In order that the table contained in 15 section 133 of title 28, United States Code, reflects the 16 changes in the total number of permanent district judge-17 ships authorized by subsection (a) of this section, the item 18 relating to California in such table is amended to read as 19 follows:

"Southern 11.".

20 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

There are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act, including such sums as may be necessary to provide appropriate space and facilities for the judicial positions created by this Act.

1 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 This Act shall take effect on the date of enactment3 of this Act.
