4	TO HOSPITALS UNDER MEDICARE.
5	Effective for cost reporting periods beginning on or
6	after October 1, 1999, for purposes of payments to hos-
7	pitals under the medicare program under title XVIII of
8	the Social Security Act for costs of approved educational
9	activities (as defined in section 413.85 of title 42 of the
10	Code of Federal Regulations), such approved educational
11	activities shall include professional educational training
12	programs, recognized by the Secretary, for psychologists,
13	physician assistants, and nurse practitioners.
