Mr. WU (for himself and Mr. FLETCHER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to ensure that senior citizens are given an opportunity to serve as mentors, tutors, and volunteers for certain programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Seniors in Our Schools
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Except as otherwise specifically provided, whenever in
8 this Act an amendment or repeal is expressed in terms

1 of an amendment to, or a repeal of, a section or other
2 provision, the reference shall be considered to be made to
3 a section or other provision of the Elementary and Sec-
4 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6301 et seq.).

5 **SEC. 3. 21st CENTURY LEARNING CENTERS.**

6 Section 10904(a)(2) (20 U.S.C. 8244(a)(2)) is
7 amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (D), by striking “and”
9 after the semicolon;

10 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (E) as sub-
11 paragraph (F); and

12 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (D) the fol-
13 lowing:

14 “(E) a description of how the school or
15 consortium will encourage and use appro-
16 priately trained senior citizens as volunteers in
17 activities identified under section 10905; and”.

18 **SEC. 4. GOVERNOR’S PROGRAMS.**

19 Section 4114(c) (20 U.S.C. 7114(c)) is amended—

20 (1) in paragraph (11), by striking “and” after
21 the semicolon; and

22 (2) by redesignating paragraph (12) as para-
23 graph (13);

24 (3) by inserting after paragraph (11) the fol-
25 lowing:

1 “(12) drug and violence prevention activities
2 that use the services of appropriately trained senior
3 citizens for activities that include mentoring, tutor-
4 ing, and volunteering; and”.

5 **SEC. 5. LOCAL DRUG AND VIOLENCE PREVENTION PRO-**
6 **GRAMS.**

7 Section 4116(b) (20 U.S.C. 7116(b)) is amended—
8 (1) in paragraph (2)—

9 (A) after “mentoring” insert “(including
10 mentoring by senior citizens)”;

11 (B) in subparagraph (C)—

12 (i) in clause (ii), by striking “and”;

13 and

14 (ii) by adding after clause (iii) the fol-
15 lowing:

16 “(iv) drug and violence prevention ac-
17 tivities that use the services of appro-
18 priately trained senior citizens for such ac-
19 tivities as mentoring, tutoring, and volun-
20 teering;”;

21 (2) in paragraph (4)(C), by inserting “(includ-
22 ing mentoring by senior citizens) after “mentoring
23 programs”; and

1 (3) in paragraph (8), by inserting “and that
2 may involve senior citizens working with students”
3 after “settings”.

4 **SEC. 6. NATIONAL PROGRAMS.**

5 Section 4121(a) (20 U.S.C. 7131(a)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (10), by inserting “, including
7 projects and activities that promote the interaction
8 of youth and senior citizens” after “responsibility”;
9 and

10 (2) in paragraph (13), by inserting “, including
11 activities that integrate appropriately trained senior
12 citizens for activities such as mentoring, tutoring,
13 and volunteering” after “title”.
