For the relief of certain corporations from a tax liability incurred by the import in 1994 and 1995 of Halon-1211 for recycling purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. RELIEF FROM EXCISE TAX LIABILITY FOR IM-4 PORT OF HALON-1211 FOR RECYCLING PUR-5 POSES. 6 In the case of the corporations with taxpayer identi-7 fication numbers 23–2342674 and 77–0384905— 8 (1) such corporations are relieved of liability for 9 tax under section 4681 of the Internal Revenue

Code of 1986 (including interest and penalties) for

the importation of recovered or recycled Halon-1211 1 2 in 1994 and 1995, and 3 (2) all excise tax paid by such corporations for 4 such importation under section 4681 of such Code 5 shall be treated as an overpayment, as of the date of receipt by the Secretary of the Treasury 6 of a certificate evidencing the destruction by such corporations, during the one-year period beginning on the date 8 of the enactment of this Act, of 75,197 pounds of Halon-1211 at a facility approved by the Environmental Protec-10 11 tion Agency.
