A BILL

To prohibit the export to the People's Republic of China of satellites and related items.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON EXPORTS TO CHINA OF SAT-
- 4 ELLITES AND RELATED ITEMS.
- 5 Notwithstanding any provision of subtitle B of title
- 6 XV of the Strom Thurmond National Defense Authoriza-
- 7 tion Act for Fiscal Year 1999 (22 U.S.C. 2778 note), or
- 8 section 902 of the Foreign Relations Authorization Act,
- 9 Fiscal Years 1990 and 1991 (22 U.S.C. 2151 note), no

- 1 satellite of United States origin or related items may be
- 2 exported to the People's Republic of China.

3 SEC. 2. DEFINITION.

- 4 As used in this Act, the term "related items" means
- 5 the satellite fuel, ground support equipment, test equip-
- 6 ment, payload adapter or interface hardware, replacement
- 7 parts, and non-embedded solid propellant orbit transfer
- 8 engines described in the report submitted to Congress by
- 9 the Department of State on February 6, 1998, pursuant
- 10 to section 38(f) of the Arms Export Control Act (22
- 11 U.S.C. 2778(f)).
