- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Saint-Gaudens Na-
- 5 tional Historic Site Improvement Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.
- 7 The Act of August 31, 1964 (78 Stat. 749), which
- 8 established Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site, is
- 9 amended—

1	(1) in section 3 by striking "not to exceed sixty-
2	four acres of lands and interests therein" and insert-
3	ing "215 acres of lands and buildings, or interests
4	therein";
5	(2) in section 6 by striking "\$2,677,000" from
6	the first sentence and inserting "\$10,632,000"; and
7	(3) in section 6 by striking "\$80,000" from the
8	last sentence and inserting "\$2.000.000".
