- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Women's Health Inno-
- 5 vation Improvement Act of 1999".

## 1 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN MEDICARE PAYMENT AMOUNT FOR

- 2 PAP SMEAR LABORATORY TESTS.
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1833(h) of the Social Se-
- 4 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(h)) is amended by adding at
- 5 the end the following new paragraph:
- 6 "(7)(A) In no case shall payment under the fee sched-
- 7 ule established under paragraph (1) for the laboratory test
- 8 component of a diagnostic or screening pap smear be less
- 9 than \$13.
- 10 "(B) Payment for a laboratory test component of a
- 11 diagnostic pap smear that is conducted using automated
- 12 primary screening shall be equal to 140 percent of pay-
- 13 ment amount for such test under such fee schedule.".
- 14 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 15 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to laboratory tests
- 16 furnished on or after January 1, 2000.

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
