A BILL

For the relief of Bruce Watson Pairman and Daniele Paule Pairman.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR BRUCE
 WATSON PAIRMAN AND DANIELE PAULE
 PAIRMAN.
 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality

8 Act, Bruce Watson Pairman and Daniele Paule Pairman
9 shall be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for
10 adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted
11 for permanent residence upon filing an application for

issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such
 Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resi dent.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Bruce Watson 5 Pairman or Daniele Paule Pairman enters the United States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), 6 7 he or she shall be considered to have entered and remained 8 lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for ad-9 justment of status under section 245 of the Immigration 10 and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of 11 this Act.

12 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF 13 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-14 15 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 16 17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.— Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-18 19 idence to Bruce Watson Pairman and Daniele Paule 20Pairman, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper 21 officer to reduce by 2, during the current or next following 22 fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are 23 made available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth 24 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality 25 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

that are made available to natives of the country of the
 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.

3 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
4 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
5 parents, brothers, and sisters of Bruce Watson Pairman
6 and Daniele Paule Pairman shall not, by virtue of such
7 relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or status
8 under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
