## A BILL

To extend energy conservation programs under the Energy Policy and Conservation Act through March 31, 2000.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENERGY POLICY AND CONSERVATION ACT**

4 **AMENDMENTS.**

5 The Energy Policy and Conservation Act is  
6 amended—

7 (1) by amending section 166 (42 U.S.C. 6246)

8 to read as follows:

1                   “AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS

2           “SEC. 166. There are authorized to be appropriated  
3 for fiscal year 2000 such sums as may be necessary to  
4 implement this part, to remain available only through  
5 March 31, 2000.”;

6                   (2) in section 181 (42 U.S.C. 6251) by striking  
7           “September 30, 1999” both places it appears and  
8           inserting in lieu thereof “March 31, 2000”; and

9                   (3) in section 281 (42 U.S.C. 6285) by striking  
10          “September 30, 1999” both places it appears and  
11          inserting in lieu thereof “March 31, 2000”.
