## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to complete construction of the Hubbard Expressway in the vicinity of Youngstown, Ohio.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. HUBBARD EXPRESSWAY.**

4       (a) PROJECT DESCRIPTION.—The Secretary of  
5       Transportation shall carry out a highway project in the  
6       vicinity of Youngstown, Ohio, to complete construction of  
7       the Hubbard Expressway.

8       (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is  
9       authorized to be appropriated, out of the Highway Trust  
10      Fund (other than the Mass Transit Account), to carry out

1 subsection (a) \$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2000,  
2 2001, 2002, and 2003.

3 (c) APPLICABILITY OF TITLE 23.—Funds authorized  
4 by this section shall be available for obligation in the same  
5 manner as if such funds were apportioned under chapter  
6 1 of title 23, United States Code; except that the Federal  
7 share of the cost of the project under this section shall  
8 be 80 percent and such funds shall remain available until  
9 expended. Such funds shall not be subject to any obliga-  
10 tion limitation.
