A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located 935 Pennsylvania Ave-
5 nue, NW, in Washington, DC, commonly known as the
6 J. Edgar Hoover Federal Building, shall be known and
7 designated as the “Frank M. Johnson Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Frank M. Johnson Federal Building”.
