A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to permit retired members of the Armed Forces who retired with over 20 years of service and who have service-connected disabilities to receive compensation from the Department of Veterans Affairs concurrently with retired pay, without deduction from either.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That section 5304(a)(1) of title 38, United States Code,
- 4 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
- 5 "Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, emergency offi-
- 6 cers', regular, or reserve retirement pay (other than re-

- 1 tired pay under chapter 61 of title 10) may be paid to
- 2 a veteran concurrently with compensation for a service-
- 3 connected disability, without deduction from either the re-
- 4 tirement pay or the compensation, in the case of a veteran
- 5 whose retirement pay is based on service of 20 years or

6 more.".
