To prohibit mining on a certain tract of Federal land in Los Angeles County, California, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. WITHDRAWAL.
- 4 The lands adjacent to Soledad Canyon Road in Los
- 5 Angeles County, California, as depicted on the map dated
- 6 May 5, 1999, and numbered D-ES-99-13, which shall be
- 7 on file in the offices of the Bureau of Land Management,
- 8 Department of the Interior, are hereby withdrawn from
- 9 the operation of the mining and mineral leasing laws of
- 10 the United States. Any lease or permit issued by the Sec-

- 1 retary of the Interior for mining on such lands is hereby
- 2 withdrawn, and all mining activities and relating activities
- 3 on such lands shall immediately cease on the enactment

4 of this Act.
