A BILL

To prohibit mining on a certain tract of Federal land in
Los Angeles County, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WITHDRAWAL.**

4 The lands adjacent to Soledad Canyon Road in Los
5 Angeles County, California, as depicted on the map dated
6 May 5, 1999, and numbered D-ES-99-13, which shall be
7 on file in the offices of the Bureau of Land Management,
8 Department of the Interior, are hereby withdrawn from
9 the operation of the mining and mineral leasing laws of
10 the United States. Any lease or permit issued by the Sec-

1 retary of the Interior for mining on such lands is hereby
2 withdrawn, and all mining activities and relating activities
3 on such lands shall immediately cease on the enactment
4 of this Act.
