3 SECTION 1. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF IMMUNO4 SUPPRESSIVE DRUGS FOR TRANSPLANTS
5 NOT PAID FOR UNDER MEDICARE.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(s)(2)(J) of the So7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(2)(J)) is amended

by striking "for which payment is made under this title"
 and inserting "whether or not payment is made for the
 transplant under this title".

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) applies to prescription drugs furnished on
6 or after October 1, 2000, regardless of when the organ
7 transplant was performed.

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
