## A BILL

To designate the Old Executive Office Building located at 17th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, in Washington, District of Columbia, as the Dwight D. Eisenhower Executive Office Building.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER EX-**  
4       **ECUTIVE OFFICE BUILDING.**

5       The Old Executive Office Building located at 17th  
6       Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, in Washington,  
7       District of Columbia, shall be known and designated as  
8       the “Dwight D. Eisenhower Executive Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
5 to the Dwight D. Eisenhower Executive Office Building.
