  - 6 Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, in Washington,
  - 7 District of Columbia, shall be known and designated as
  - 8 the "Dwight D. Eisenhower Executive Office Building".

- 2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
- 4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
- 5 to the Dwight D. Eisenhower Executive Office Building.
