# A BILL

To amend title 49 of the United States Code to require automobile manufacturers to provide automatic door locks on new passenger cars manufactured after 2003.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Auto Safety Assurance
- 5 Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTOMATIC AUTOMOBILE DOOR LOCKS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Title 49 of the United States
- 8 Code is amended by inserting after section 30127 the fol-
- 9 lowing new section:

### 1 "§ 30128. Automatic door locks

- 2 "(a) Not later than January 1, 2001, the Secretary
- 3 of Transportation shall prescribe under this chapter an
- 4 amendment to Federal Motor Vehicle Standard 206 issued
- 5 under the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act
- 6 of 1966. The amendment shall require that all passenger
- 7 cars manufactured after January 1, 2003 shall be fitted
- 8 with equipment which automatically locks the doors of the
- 9 vehicle when—
- "(1) the vehicle transmission is engaged; or
- 11 "(2) the vehicle reaches a specified rate of
- speed.".
- 13 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table at the begin-
- 14 ning of subtitle IV of title 49, United States Code, is
- 15 amended by adding after the item related to section 30127
- 16 the following new item:

"30128. Automatic door locks.".
