3 **SECTION 1. ACQUISITION OF HUNT HOUSE.**

6 (1) in the first sentence, by inserting after
7 “park,” the following: “including the Hunt House
8 designated under subsection (c)(8),”; and

- 2 tock” and inserting “Hunt”.
