To amend the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 to temporarily continue authority relating to transfers of certain surplus property to State and local governments for law enforcement and emergency response purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 203(p)(1)(B)(ii) of the Federal Property and
4 Administrative Services Act of 1949 (40 U.S.C.
5 484(p)(1)(B)(ii)) is amended by striking “December 31,
6 1999.” and inserting “July 31, 2000. During the period
7 beginning January 1, 2000, and ending July 31, 2000,

1 the Administrator may not convey any property under
2 subparagraph (A), but may accept, consider, and approve
3 applications for transfer of property under that subpara-
4 graph.”.
