1 SECTION 1. DISEASES INCURRED OR AGGRAVATED BY A 2 MEMBER OF A RESERVE COMPONENT IN THE 3 PERFORMANCE OF DUTY WHILE PER-4 FORMING INACTIVE DUTY TRAINING TO BE 5 CONSIDERED TO BE SERVICE-CONNECTED 6 FOR PURPOSES OF BENEFITS UNDER LAWS 7 ADMINISTERED BY THE SECRETARY OF VET-8 ERANS AFFAIRS.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(24) of title 38, 10 United States Code, is amended by inserting before the 11 period at the end the following: "or from a disease in-12 curred or aggravated in performance of duty".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall apply with respect to diseases incurred
or aggravated in performance of duty during a period of
inactive duty training performed on or after October 17,
17 1997.
