## A BILL

To delay the effective date of the final rule regarding the Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. NULLIFICATION AND REQUIREMENT FOR FUR-4 THER RULEMAKING.

5 (a) LIMITATION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-6 sion of law, the final rule relating to the Organ Procure-7 ment and Transplantation Network, promulgated by the 8 Secretary of Health and Human Services and published 9 in the Federal Register on April 2, 1998 (63 Fed. Reg. 10 16296 et seq. adding part 121 to title 42, Code of Federal

Regulations) and amended on October 20, 1999 (64 Fed. 1 2 Reg. 56649 et seq.), shall have no force or legal effect. 3 (b) NO IMPLEMENTATION OR AUTHORITY.—The Sec-4 retary of Health and Human Services shall not implement 5 or exercise additional regulatory authority with respect to 6 the Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network, as 7 well as regulatory authority under sections 1102, 1106, 1138, and 1871 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 8 9 1302, 1306, 1320b-8, and 1395hh), prior to the date of 10 enactment of amendments to reauthorize and revise part 11 H of title III of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 12 273 et seq.).
