A BILL

To authorize States under Federal health care grant-in-aid programs to require parental consent or notification for purpose of purchase of prescription drugs or devices for minors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “State’s and Parental
3 Rights Improvement Act of 2000”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR STATES TO REQUIRE PAREN-**
5 **TAL CONSENT OR NOTIFICATION FOR PUR-**
6 **POSE OF PURCHASE OF PRESCRIPTION**
7 **DRUGS OR DEVICES FOR MINORS UNDER**
8 **FEDERAL HEALTH CARE GRANT-IN-AID PRO-**
9 **GRAMS.**

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a State
11 shall not be considered to have violated any term or condi-
12 tion of any Federal health care grant-in-aid program inso-
13 far as the State requires the consent or notification of a
14 parent or guardian with respect to the dispensing of a pre-
15 scription drug or device (or any class of drugs or devices
16 specified by the State) to a minor.
