3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL CEMETERY.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
5 shall establish, in accordance with chapter 24 of title 38,
6 United States Code, a national cemetery in the Albu7 querque, New Mexico, metropolitan area to serve the
8 needs of veterans and their families.

9 (b) REPORT.—As soon as practicable after the date10 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit

to Congress a report that sets forth a schedule for the
 establishment of the national cemetery under subsection
 (a) and an estimate of the costs associated with such es tablishment.
