Ms. CARSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Adela T. and Darryl Bailor.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT.**

4 In consideration of—

5 (1) the inability of Adela T. and Darryl Bailor
6 to receive compensation under the Tort Claims Pro-
7 cedure described in chapter 171 of title 28, United
8 States Code;

9 (2) the moral responsibility of the United
10 States to protect the right of its law-abiding citizens
11 to be free from attacks by violent felons in the cus-
12 tody of the United States; and

1 (3) the recommendation of the United States
2 Court of Appeals for the 7th Circuit in the case enti-
3 tled Adela T. Bailor and Darryl Bailor v. the Salva-
4 tion Army and the United States of America, No.
5 94–2660, that Adela T. and Darryl Bailor seek pri-
6 vate legislative relief,
7 the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, not later than
8 18 months after the date of the enactment of this Act,
9 out of funds not otherwise appropriated, to Adela T. and
10 Darryl Bailor of Colorado Springs, Colorado, the amount
11 determined by the Attorney General under section 2(b),
12 as full compensation for the injuries Adela T. Bailor suf-
13 fered as a result of a brutal rape and beating on May 9,
14 1991, by an inmate of the Federal correctional system in
15 the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons.

16 **SEC. 2. AMOUNT.**

17 (a) TRANSMITTAL OF CLAIMS.—Not later than 6
18 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, Adela
19 T. and Darryl Bailor, or their representatives, shall trans-
20 mit to the Attorney General all claims for compensation
21 for the injuries referred to in section 1.

22 (b) DETERMINATION OF THE ATTORNEY GEN-
23 ERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the date of the enact-
24 ment of this Act, with appropriate consideration given to
25 the claims transmitted under subsection (a), the Attorney

- 1 General shall determine the amount that the United
- 2 States owes, using Indiana tort law, to Adela T. and
- 3 Darryl Bailor for the injuries referred to in section 1.
