Mr. HAYWORTH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To provide for correction of an administrative error in the computation of the retired pay of Commander Carl D. Swanson, United States Coast Guard Reserve, retired.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CORRECTION OF UNDERPAYMENT OF RETIRED**
4 **PAY.**

5 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT.—The Secretary
6 of Transportation shall pay, out of funds currently avail-
7 able for payment of Coast Guard retired pay, the sum of
8 \$2,464.22 to Commander Carl D. Swanson, United States
9 Coast Guard Reserve, retired, of Mesa, Arizona, such sum

1 being the amount by which the retired pay of Commander
2 Swanson was underpaid for the period beginning on Octo-
3 ber 13, 1972, and ending on January 31, 1986, due to
4 an acknowledged administrative error, administrative cor-
5 rection of which is barred by the applicable statute of limi-
6 tations.

7 (b) SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS.—The payment made
8 under subsection (a) shall be a full settlement of all claims
9 by Commander Swanson against the United States arising
10 from the underpayment of retired pay referred to in sub-
11 section (a).

12 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS' FEES.**

13 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
14 percent of the amount authorized by section 1 to be paid
15 to or received by any agent or attorney in consideration
16 of services rendered in connection with this Act. Any per-
17 son who violates this section shall be guilty of an infrac-
18 tion and shall be subject to a fine in the amount provided
19 in title 18, United States Code.
