## A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on the chemical KL084.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) CALENDER YEAR 2000.—Subchapter II of chap-  
5 ter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United  
6 States is amended by inserting in the numerical sequence  
7 the following new heading:

“	9902.29.30	2-imino-1-methoxycarbonyl-piperidine hydrochloride (CAS No. 159393-48-3) (provided for in subheading 2933.39.61) ....	6.8%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2000	”.

1 (b) CALENDAR YEAR 2001.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.30 of the  
3 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States, as  
4 added by subsection (a), is amended—

5 (A) by striking “6.8%” and inserting  
6 “6.1%”; and

7 (B) by striking “On or before 12/31/2000”  
8 and inserting “On or before 12/31/2001”.

9 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
10 by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,  
11 2001.

12 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
13 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or  
14 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
15 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
