A BILL

To establish certain procedures regarding the appointment and tenure of persons to the International St. Lawrence River Board of Control established by the International Joint Commission under the Boundary Waters Treaty of 1909.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO INTER-
- 4 NATIONAL ST. LAWRENCE RIVER BOARD OF
- 5 CONTROL.
- 6 The following shall apply to persons who serve on the
- 7 United States section of the International River Board of

- 1 Control established by the International Joint Commission
- 2 under the Order of Approval for Regulation of Lake On-
- 3 tario:
- 4 (1) Terms.—A term of a member of the Board
- 5 of Control may not exceed 2 years, and a person
- 6 may not serve more than 2 consecutive terms. Mem-
- 7 bers shall be appointed so that the terms do not ter-
- 8 minate in the same year.
- 9 (2) APPOINTMENT.—(A) Persons under consid-
- eration for appointment to the Board of Control
- shall be announced publicly and should be appointed
- only after an opportunity has been given to the pub-
- lic to submit comments on the candidates for ap-
- pointment.
- (B) A person must be approved as a member of
- the Board of Control by a recorded vote of a major-
- ity of the members of the International Joint Com-
- mission.
- 19 (C) The vote must be held in open session.

20 SEC. 2. PROCEDURES APPLICABLE TO OTHER BOARDS.

- The procedures set forth in section 1 shall apply to
- 22 any other board or similar body established by the Inter-
- 23 national Joint Commission to carry out instructions of the
- 24 Joint Commission with respect to its functions under the
- 25 Treaty.

- 3 (1) International joint commission; joint 4 COMMISSION.—The terms "International Joint Commission" and "Joint Commission" mean the Inter-5 6 national Joint Commission established under the 7 Treaty Between the United States and Great Britain 8 Relating to Boundary Waters, and Questions Arising 9 Between the United States and Canada, of January 10 11, 1909.
 - (2) TREATY.—The term "Treaty" means the treaty described in paragraph (1).
 - (3) ORDER OF APPROVAL FOR REGULATION OF LAKE ONTARIO.—The term "Order of Approval for Regulation of Lake Ontario" means the order of Approval for Regulation of Lake Ontario, issued by the Joint Commission on October 29, 1952, as amended by a supplementary order of the Joint Commission on July 2, 1956.
