1	SECTION 1. REQUIRING PROVISION OF THERAPY SERVICES
2	BY A COMPREHENSIVE OUTPATIENT REHA-
3	BILITATION FACILITY (CORF) UNDER THE
4	MEDICARE PROGRAM AT A SINGLE FIXED
5	LOCATION.
6	(a) In General.—Section 1861(cc)(1) of the Social
7	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(cc)(1)) is amended—
8	(1) in subparagraph (B), by inserting "fur-
9	nished at a single fixed facility" before the semi-
10	colon; and
11	(2) by striking the last sentence.
12	(b) Effective Date.—
13	(1) In general.—Subject to paragraph (2),
14	the amendments made by subsection (a) apply to
15	services furnished on or after November 17, 1999.
16	(2) Transition.—In the case of a comprehen-
17	sive outpatient rehabilitation facility that was pro-
18	viding physical therapy, occupational therapy,
19	speech-language pathology services, and respiratory
20	therapy on an ongoing basis at more than one speci-
21	fied location as of November 17, 1999, the amend-
22	ments made by subsection (a) shall not apply with
23	respect to therapy furnished at such other locations
24	until one month after the date of the enactment of
25	this Act.
